## Introduction

On 10 September 2016, the NSW Electoral Commission (NSWEC) conducted elections on behalf of 75 NSW councils. We also conducted a separate election on 29 October 2016 for Tweed Shire Council, after the death of a candidate during the election period forced the postponement of that election.

Five councils (Fairfield, Gunnedah, Kempsey, Lake Macquarie and Penrith) chose to conduct their own elections.

In total, we were responsible for 144 individual elections in 63 wards and 58 undivided council areas. There were 679 councillor positions available in the 114 contested councillor elections and seven uncontested councillor elections. There were also 17 contested mayoral elections and referenda for six councils.

As required by clause 393AA of the *Local Government (General) Regulation 2005*, on 10 March 2017 the NSWEC published a report on the conduct of those elections. That report provided an overview of the preparation for, and conduct of, the elections, together with the overall ballot results and an analysis of surveys undertaken after the elections.

This supplementary report provides detailed information on the elections conducted for individual councils including results, votes received by each candidate and a breakdown of the electoral services provided by the NSWEC.

Similar reports will be produced for the 2017 Local Government Elections.
