I being the party agent for the above named registered political party or independent elected member of the NSW Parliament claim an amount of \$ for the third quarter of the 2023 calendar year.

I understand that:

1. the amount of any payment made in advance to the party or the independent elected member by the Electoral Commission for the third quarter of the 2023 calendar year will be deducted from the quarterly payment amount claimed here,
2. the amount claimed here includes only administrative or operating expenses incurred for the third quarter of the 2023 calendar year,
3. if the amount claimed here is less than any payment made in advance to the party or independent elected member, the difference must be repaid to the NSW Electoral Commission, and
4. to be eligible to receive public funding payments the party or independent elected member must have no outstanding disclosure obligations or annual audited financial statements and for parties, must provide and promptly notify the NSW Electoral Commission of changes to a list of its senior office holders and a summary of their roles and responsibilities.

This claim must be lodged by 31 December 2023.
