<p>which is eligible for an advance payment from the Election Campaigns Fund under section 72 of the <i>Electoral Funding Act 2018</i>, claim the above-stated amount in accordance with section 73 of the <i>Electoral Funding Act 2018</i> in respect of electoral expenditure to be incurred in connection with the 2023 NSW State Election.</p> <p>I understand the amount paid to the party as an advance payment will be deducted from the amount payable to the party from the Election Campaigns Fund after the 2023 NSW State Election.</p> <p>In accordance with section 72(5) of the <i>Electoral Funding Act 2018</i>, if the party receives an advance payment in excess of the amount to which it becomes entitled in respect of the general election, the excess amount must be repaid to the NSW Electoral Commission within 60 days of the return of the writs for that general election. Section 72(6) of the <i>Electoral Funding Act 2018</i> requires a party to repay to the NSW Electoral Commission any amount it receives by way of advance payment if it becomes ineligible before, or does not contest, the general election.</p> <p>To be eligible for public funding payments a party must provide, and promptly notify the NSW Electoral Commission of changes to the list of its senior office holders and a summary of their roles and responsibilities. By signing this claim I declare that the above named party remains compliant in this respect.</p> <p>I have taken reasonable steps to ensure that the information provided in this claim is not false or misleading in a material particular including taking reasonable steps to ensure that I have not omitted any matter or thing without which this claim would be misleading in a material particular.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> I understand that giving false or misleading information is a serious offence.</p>
